Rt. 66 Road Ahead Announces Changes to Board Membership

Sharon Foster and Gary Daggett have replaced Scott Piotrowski and Larry Clonts on the Road Ahead Board of Directors as representatives from California and Texas. Board Chairman Bill Thomas made the announcement via email on May 9, 2018.

Scott Piotrowski has resigned from his service as the Board representative from California these past couple years and following his contributions to the Road Ahead Steering Committee, which helped establish the Road Ahead Partnership. Replacing Piotrowski as the Board representative from the Sunshine State, is Sharon Foster, the current president of the California Historic Route 66 Association. Sharon has been active in the California association for a number of years and helped organize the very successful Route 66 Economic Development Symposium held in Barstow in 2016.

Gary Daggett, of Bushland, Texas will replace Larry Clonts as the Lone Star state representative. Gary is a railroad engineer who has done extensive travels on Route 66, is a member of several different Rt. 66 state associations, and partners with his wife, Stephanie, in running a home-based Route 66 business known as Mother Road Naturals, that features homemade soaps.

“Join me in thanking Larry and Scott for their service, and in welcoming Sharon and Gary to our Board,” said Thomas.

Established in 2015, with the support of the National Park Service and the World Monuments' Fund, The Road Ahead Partnership's mission is to revitalize and sustain Route 66 as a national and international icon through partnerships focused on promotion, preservation, research and education, as well as economic development.
